Tetanus

Tetanus is a rare but serious bacterial infection and is caused by skin being broken by a bite or other open wound. It is a condition of volunteering at Happy Landings that you are up to date with your tetanus vaccination, which forms part of normal childhood vaccinations. If you are unsure, you will need to ask your GP surgery.

Before commencing any volunteer role with Happy Landings Animal Rescue, you will be required to read and sign the Volunteer Policy. It is not intended that a volunteer should have the status of employee or worker in relation to the volunteering activities undertaken, or that they should derive a personal benefit from undertaking such activities.
